IMPORTANT TIPS

Vote early — be an October voter!

You don't need a stamp to mail your ballot, the Postal Service will still deliver your ballot to your county clerk's office.

Track your ballot to make sure it is received and counted.

CHECK YOUR VOTER STATUS ★★★★★★★★★★★★★★

Always double-check your voter registration to make sure you are registered to vote and your ballot is sent to the correct address. Check your voter registration here: votesearch.utah.gov

The earlier you check your voter registration, the easier it is for the County Clerk to make any necessary changes.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE TO VOTE? ★★★★★★★★★★★★★★

To be eligible to vote in Utah you must:

- ★ Be a U.S. citizen.
- ★ Be a resident of Utah at least 30 days before the election.
- ★ Be at least 18 years old on the day of the election.
